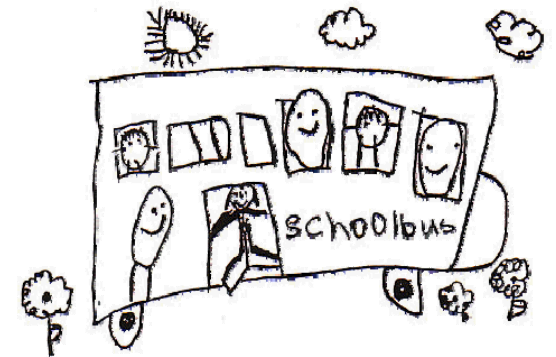

# Children will need to bring:

- ☺ Bag
- ☺ Water Bottle
- ☺ Change of Clothes
- ☺ Hat
- ☺ Footwear—appropriate footwear does not include thongs, crocs or slip on shoes
- ☺ Snack—in line with the Kindergarten's Healthy Eating Policy

You will be required to sign your child in and pay prior to leaving your child in the centre.

## Booking your child in for Occasional Care

- Bookings will be taken up to one week in advance you may call on the Thursday prior to the day
- Permanent Bookings can not be made

### Fee Structure:

\$5.00 per session for one child

\$1.50 if a valid Health Care Card is presented

- Families with more than one child attending the same session pay a sibling fee of 50% for the second and subsequent children.
